


Important

- Please keep these instructions for future reference.


Automatic Shut Off: Your game unit will shut off automatically after thirty seconds of non-use.

Object of the Game

It's simple, dude. I'm going to run you down with my skateboard! See how many times you can jump out of the way.



Clip me onto your pocket, belt, backpack, or whatever, and bring my game wherever you go! It's easy to play. Just press buttons to stay out of my way as I skateboard toward you! The flashing lights show you how and when to move. For example: press any button except the red one when the red light flashes and I'll miss you. But if you press the red button just as the red light flashes, I'll run into you - and you'll know it! The same thing goes for the other two colors. You'll score a point each time I miss you! But after I smack into you three times, the game is over. Then listen up and I'll "announce" your final score!

How to Play

I just told you how to play, but now you want more? Get a life.

OK. Press any of the buttons on the game to turn it on. You'll hear me greet you... "politely."

You will then see three lights - yellow, green, and red - begin flashing in sequence.

The Red button corresponds to the Red light, the Green button corresponds to the Green light, and the Yellow button corresponds to the Yellow light.

The lights will flash in the same order for awhile. But, each time you correctly press a button to stay out of my way, the flash sequence will speed up a bit. Sort of like the warning light at the Nuclear Power Plant where Homer works. Remember, each time you successfully dodge my skateboard, you'll score one point.

Wait. I don't want to make this too easy. So, if you avoid me eight times, the light pattern will change. And change again. And speed up. Sooner or later, you're a goner, dude.

After I hit you three times, the game is over. Then I'll proudly burp out your score — a loud burp means ten points. Short burps are one point each. Then press any button to start a new game.

The dumb battery information below didn't come from me. I'm not going read it, but you probably should. Later, dude.

Batteries

To replace the batteries, do the following:

1. Use a Phillips head screwdriver to loosen the screw on the battery compartment on the back of the unit and open the door.

2. Carefully remove the old batteries.


(Do NOT use a metallic object

to do this.)
3. Insert 3 "A76 / LR44" button batteries, making sure to align the "+" and "-" as shown.

4. Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.

In case the game malfunction or "locks up", press RESET button to initialize the unit.
